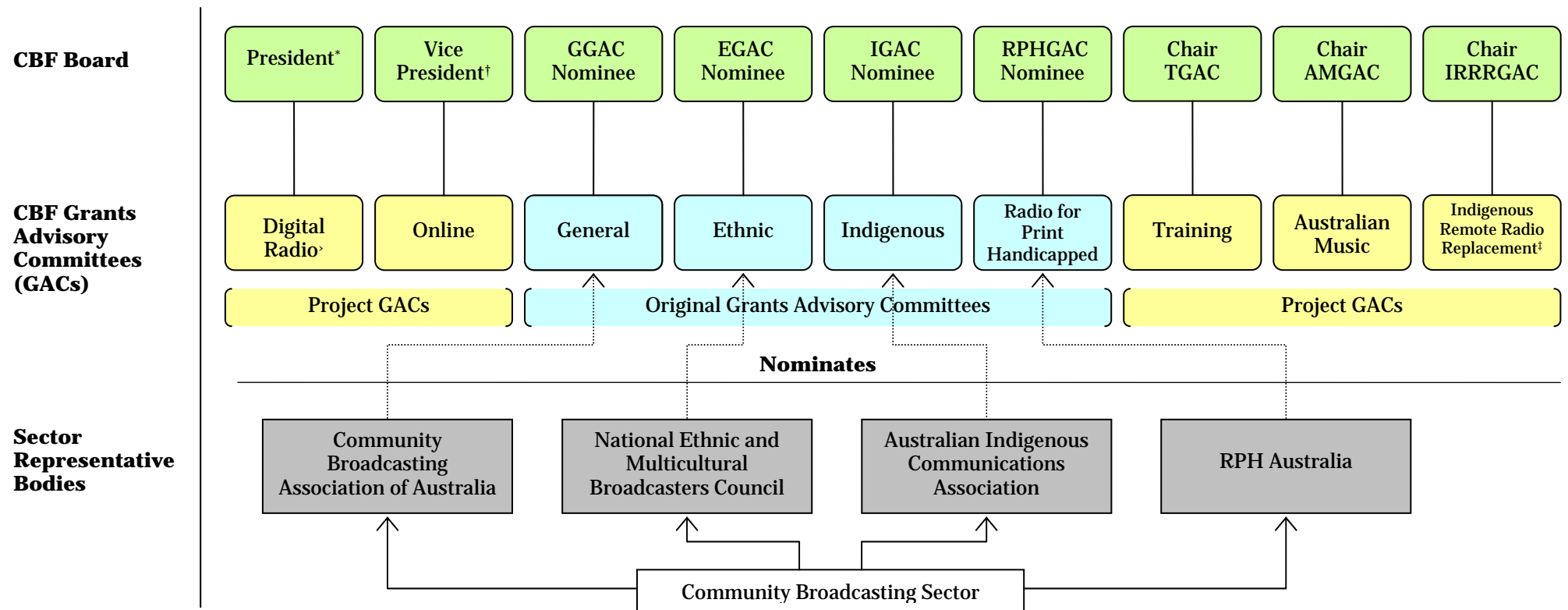


CBF Organisational Chart



- The CBF Board is currently composed of nine members, being four nominees from the original Grants Advisory Committees, three appointees to sector projects, the President and Vice President.
- Original Grants Advisory Committee members are appointed by the CBF Board from nominees of the relevant peak sector representative organisation. Once appointed these grants advisory committees select their own Chairs and nominees to the CBF Board.
- The Sector Projects Grants Advisory Committees consist of one member nominated by each of the Original Grants Advisory Committees. Their Chairs are nominated by the CBF Board.
- * The position of President is nominated by the Board of the Community Broadcasting Association of Australia.
- † The position of Vice-President is nominated by the CBF Board.
- ‡ The IRRR Grants Advisory Committee consists of one member nominated by the Australian Indigenous Communications Association, one member nominated by the Indigenous Remote Communications Association and a Chair nominated by the CBF Board.
- > The members of the Digital Radio Grants Advisory Committee are nominated by the CBF Board.
